The research group at HUJI, led by Prof. Tamar Stein, invites applications for two postdoctoral positions. The first position focuses on studying reactions in the interstellar medium, in both gas phase and ice environments. The second position will contribute to advancing density functional theory (DFT) capabilities for strongly correlated systems using the ensemble DFT formalism.

Why Join Us?

Our group is one of the few worldwide conducting state-of-the-art quantum chemistry calculations on astrochemically relevant systems. In addition, we focus on cutting-edge developments in DFT for strongly correlated systems. Awarded the prestigious ERC grant, our research stands out for its excellence and originality. The group fosters a collaborative, intellectually stimulating environment that values critical thinking, creativity, and independent research. Ideal Candidates:

Position 1: Requires expertise in quantum chemistry methods (e.g., ab initio, XMS-CASPT2, DFT, QM-MM), experience in modeling chemical reactions, and a strong interest in astrochemical processes and electronic structure theory.

Position 2: Requires robust programming skills and a strong background in DFT.
